This stunning bay has a great choice of activities and water sports, bars and places to eat ashore.

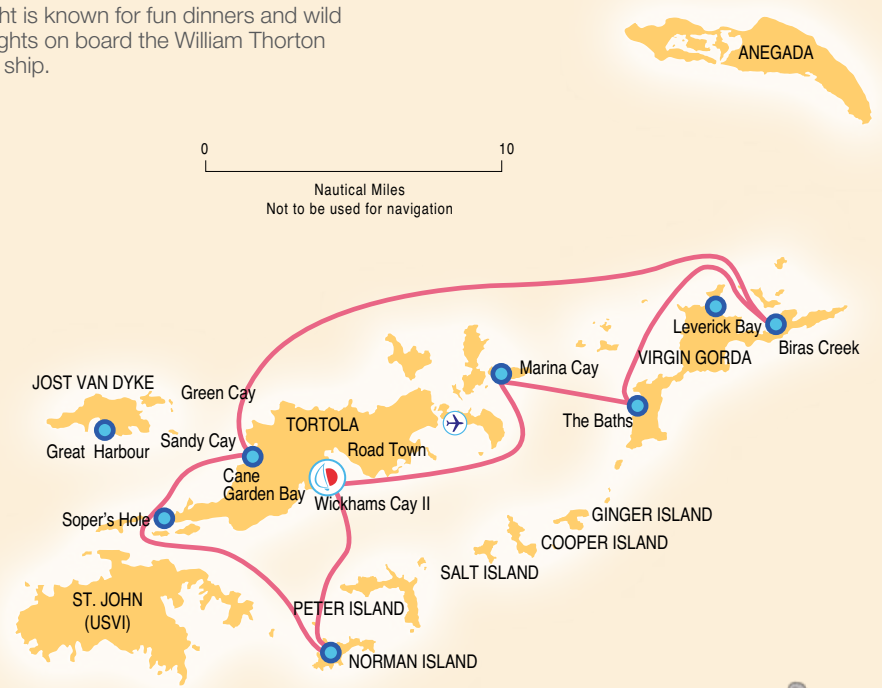
Day 6
